November 25, 2001–March 31, 2002.

The U is an exciting place to be as the 2002 Olympic Winter and Paralympic Winter Games arrive in Salt Lake City. The campus will be bustling with activity hosting the Olympic Village, the Opening and Closing Ceremonies at Rice-Eccles Stadium, and a variety of cultural events. In preparation for these events, many of the U parking lots and spaces will not be available to students, staff or faculty. As a result, consider other commuting and parking options.

Facts: 30% of Main Campus parking spaces will be used by the Salt Lake Organizing Committee while classes are in session from November 25, 2001 through March 2002 (see map on reverse side for details).

Traffic congestion may increase significantly throughout the Salt Lake Valley.

Solutions: Take UTA Bus and TRAX, car pool, or bike it.

Shuttle buses from the Stadium station will get you where you need to go on campus. UTA provides free parking at many stations. Use your U Card to ride free.

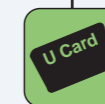
Campus Shuttle: Shuttle routes cover the entire campus including Research Park, University Hospital and U student housing. Always free.

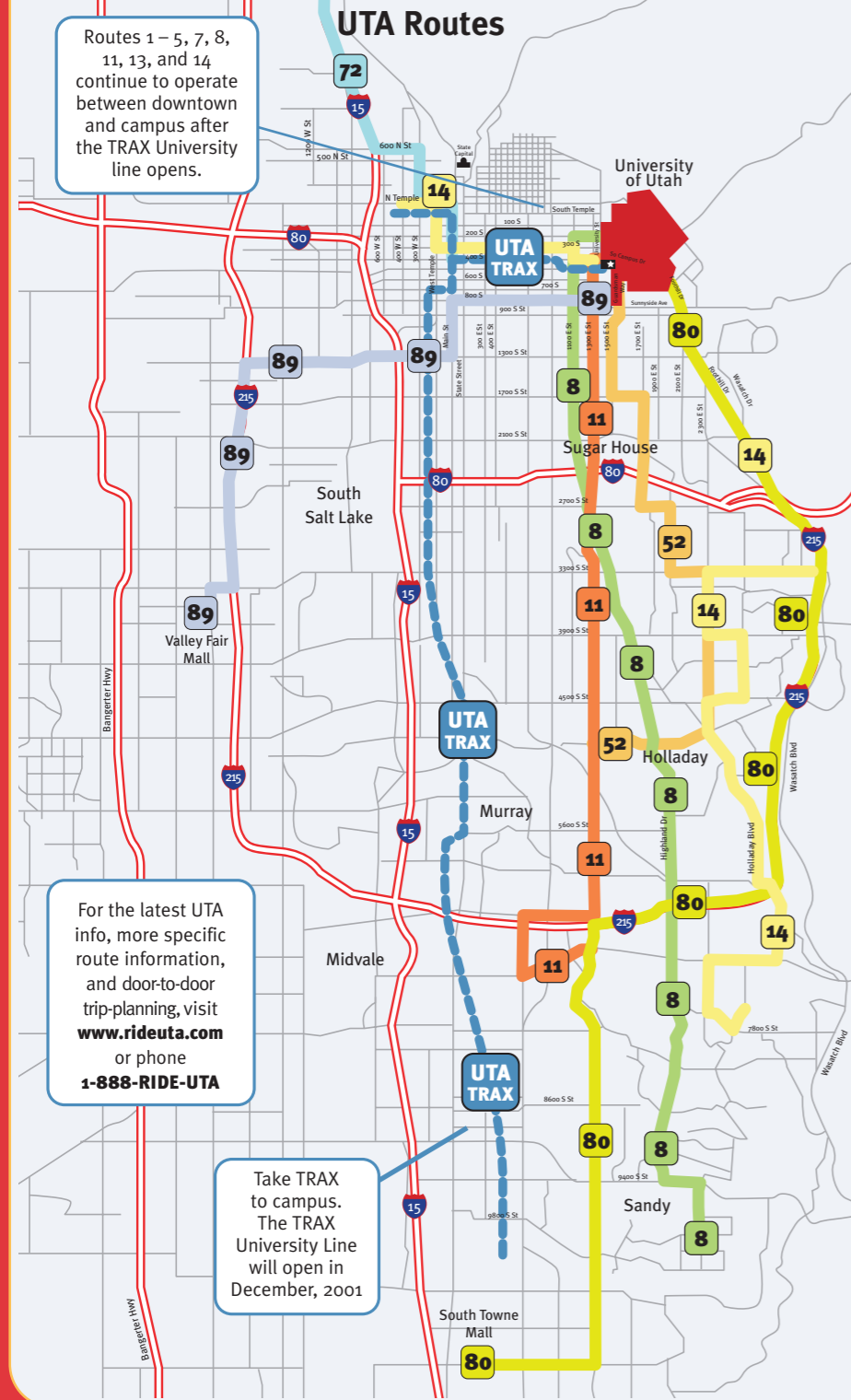
U Card: Students, staff, and faculty ride FREE on any UTA TRAX or bus. Flash your U Card and sit back and enjoy the ride.

Open to University permit parking until January 9, 2002.

During December 2001 and January, February, and most of March 2002, the West Stadium Parking Lot and the East Stadium Parking Lot will be used exclusively by SLOC for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
