

DIRECTIONS TO THE HERITAGE CENTER VIA TRAX

Service is available to the University of Utah by light rail system called “TRAX”. The University TRAX line extends from downtown Salt Lake City, heading eastbound up 400 South to campus. There are four TRAX stops within the campus itself, from the Rice-Eccles Stadium to the residence halls and the University Hospital. From Downtown Salt Lake City

- You may board a 702 University TRAX line train from any downtown TRAX station located on or *north* of 400 South.
- You may board a 703 University TRAX line train from any TRAX station located on or *south* of 400 South. (Note: the 703 line has a more intermittent schedule than the regular 702 University TRAX line. See www.rideuta.com for more details.)
- Purchase a ticket from the station and board any **eastbound** University TRAX line train. The train should say “University” in red.
- The station nearest the University Guest House is “Fort Douglas” at 200 South, Wasatch Drive.
- From the “Fort Douglas” station, walk west for a short distance to the stairs (or elevator) of the Legacy Bridge that crosses Wasatch Drive.
- Walk over the bridge (heading east).
- Continue up the sidewalk until you come to a road (Fort Douglas Blvd).
- Cross Fort Douglas Blvd at the crosswalk, and continue walking uphill (east) on the sidewalk.
- You are now walking through the residential living area of campus. The sidewalk you are on will curve around towards the right, and you will come to an area where the sidewalk converges above a large bus stop waiting area.
- Look uphill from this waiting area. A large sidewalk leads straight from the bus stop, between two identical buildings (806 & 807), to a large central building. This is the Peterson Heritage Center.
