What to wear:

Campus information:

The Office of Student Recruitment and High School Services will provide you with a Campus Tour and Information Session. You are able to see an advisor or sit in on a class. This requires prior notice of at least 7 business days so that we can make proper arrangements for you.

Where to start:

The event begins in the Peterson Heritage Center. See your attached letter for specific details.

Parking:

Park in the meters in the parking lot next to the building. Check in will take place in Peterson Heritage Center. Your first step will be to get a temporary parking pass to take back to your car and then park it in the lot.

Pick up location:

If someone will be picking you up, they can pick you up from the Peterson Heritage Center.

Meals:

Dinner and Breakfast are provided in the Heritage Center. Parents and family members are welcome to attend the campus tour and the information session. If you need housing arrangements, there is an on-campus guesthouse. You can make reservations by contacting the University Guest House at 801-587-1000.
